

Together for Nutrition 2014: *Working Across Sectors for Nutrition in India*

Submission Guidelines for Implementation Abstracts

Submission deadline: Friday, April 25, 2014

Please review the [conference announcement](#) and [background note](#) before you develop your abstract.

Abstracts will have a word limit of **500 words**, not including title, geographic location, author names and affiliations.

Please review the following indicative questions to help with the abstract development. These are only *indicative* and we do not expect full responses to these questions in all abstracts; you may include other issues in your abstract that are of relevance to the conference theme.

Each 500-word abstract should address the following:

Background: [*Indicative areas to address in this section: What was the vision and purpose of the collaboration/convergent actions for nutrition? Why was the collaboration/action initiated? Which agencies, actors, and/or sectors were involved? Who initiated it? What has been the duration of the collaboration?*] **[Word limit: 100]**

Approaches and methods for collaboration: [*Indicative areas to address in this section: What specific nutrition-focused actions were implemented in the collaboration/convergent action? What were each partner's roles? Who led the collaboration? How was it assured that each of the collaborating partners/sectors fulfilled their roles?*] **[Word limit: 200]**

Key findings: [*Indicative areas to address in this section: What were the outcomes of the implemented activities? What was the added value of the collaboration/convergence? How were they monitored and measured? What were some of the factors that you believe led to the success of the collaboration? What were some of the challenges for the collaboration?*] **[Word limit: 100]**

Significance and application: [*Indicative areas to address in this section: What do you think are the lessons from this experience for others working in nutrition in India? What was the added value of the collaboration/convergence?*] **[Word limit: 100]**
