## concentration of benefits

- The pregnant mother nutrition support program in Sri Lanka is perhaps the most far-reaching of SPprograms in terms of long-term impact.
- We test income parity of the program by estimating incidence of the nutrition program on income quantiles using 2583 households
- This distribution anomaly is prominent in urban settings but weakens when controlled for the level of education of household. We also find that clustering of benefits in this program is independent of access to other social protections.
