- Institutional Birth rate 44% and Highest NMR IMR & referral.
- Irrational & high use of antibiotics
- High use of IV fluids.
- Lack of KMC, EIB

❖ Tele SNCU & Its methodology

- Started in June 2022
- Installation 360-degree HD cameras, IOT devices,
- Hub & Spoke model of real time Tele consultation. (24x7)
- Online & hands on training at AIIMS

❖ Outcome:

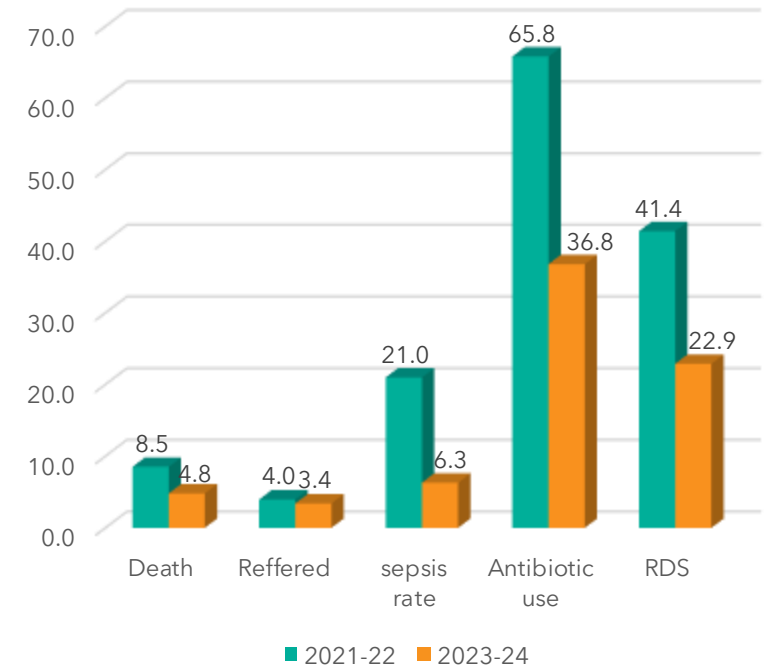
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Nursing staffs trained for 18 days FBNC residential training at AIIMS Nagpur
