Bihar Hosts High-Level Dialogue on Accelerating Sustainable and Inclusive Agricultural Growth

21 May, Patna, Bihar: The Bihar Chamber of Commerce & Industries (BCCI), in collaboration with the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI) and BiharTimes Development Foundation convened a high-level Policy Dialogue on "Accelerating Sustainable and Inclusive Agricultural Growth in Bihar" in Patna today.

The event was graced by the Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Bihar, Shri Vijay Kumar Sinha, and brought together policymakers, economists, researchers, entrepreneurs, and farmers to deliberate strategies for strengthening Bihar's rural economy through innovation, diversification, and evidence-based agricultural policy.

Underscoring Bihar's deep agrarian roots and its potential to emerge as a model for inclusive growth, **Shri Vijay Kumar Sinha, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister of Bihar**, emphasized the government's commitment to enhancing productivity and value addition in agriculture. "Bihar's future lies in modernizing its agriculture, empowering its farmers, and ensuring that our policies reflect the needs of every farmer in every village. This dialogue is a step toward aligning innovation and investment for lasting rural prosperity"

Dr. Anjani Kumar, Senior Research Fellow, IFPRI-South Asia, set the context for the dialogue and highlighted the importance of supporting smallholders through better value chains, financial access, and climate-resilient interventions. "Building on its recently signed MoU with the Government of Bihar, IFPRI aims to identify key research and development priorities aligned with the state's agricultural transformation goals. This policy dialogue serves as a vital platform to surface critical challenges and perspectives from stakeholders across the agricultural ecosystem, ensuring that future interventions are both responsive and impactful"

Underscoring the significance of convening such a multi-stakeholder dialogue, **Shri Ajay Kumar, Editor BiharTimes Development Foundation**, noted that the collaboration between BiharTimes Foundation, IFPRI, and the Bihar Chamber of Commerce reflects a promising model of civil society engagement in shaping Bihar's agricultural future. He emphasized that this is the most substantial dialogue held since the signing of the MoU between IFPRI and the Government of Bihar and marks a pivotal step forward in collective policy thinking. He also highlighted BiharTimes Development Foundation's active role in advancing agricultural development through strategic interventions- most notably, a







collaborative study with IIT Delhi on soil and water systems, and pioneering efforts to integrate agroforestry into the state's agricultural roadmap.

The thematic panel discussion, chaired by **Dr. P. K. Joshi, President of Agricultural Economics Research Association (AERA)**, covered a range of pressing issues including the role of integrated farm and non-farm systems in income generation, credit access for agricultural transformation, the significance of secondary agriculture, and insights into organic and natural farming from local practitioners.

Panelists including senior academicians, farmer leaders, and entrepreneurs shared insights on strengthening agricultural value chains, market linkages, and policies to empower women and youth in the agri-sector.

The policy dialogue reflects the state's growing momentum toward achieving the goals of the 4th Agriculture Roadmap (2023–2028), with the objective of aligning agricultural growth with employment generation, nutrition security, and inclusive economic development.
